### A Message from the CEO

Dear Readers,

2017 is going to be a busy year for Kingsgrove Community Aid Centre.

Staff and management participated in its annual planning day in February to prioritise the services for the community centre in all program areas for 2017.

Planning of our services relies on contributions and Government grants.

We are facing many challenges currently to enable us to continue with our priorities and services especially in light of the many reforms happening in the community caring sector.

These reforms will no doubt have an impact on our future and in our ability to sustain ourselves as locally based community organisations.

The fundamental impact of most of these reforms to the many community organisations across the state is that block funding which was provided to many community organisations to deliver care services to the most vulnerable such as the aged, disabled and children will now be reintroduced or redirected into the Consumer Directed Care Principles, the NDIS and the Out of School Hours Care Tenders.

Most community organisations will be forced to compete with organisations with large infrastructure's and funding bases, and those for profit providers.

For most, these changes are happening too soon and often too hurried. The saving grace is that we are still around to hold the hands of those that seek our help to assist them navigate the system.

## Chinese New Year Celebration With The Chinese Activity Group

The Chinese lunar new year fell on 28 January 2017 and was duly celebrated by members of the group. Traditionally, celebrations continue all through the first 15 days of the new year, each day having its own special significance in terms of food and associated activities. The last day of the festival is called "Valentine's Day" and was the day we celebrated with the group.

On this day every family traditionally makes and eats rice balls made from glutinous rice flour. These cooked rice balls may be either sweet, with sugar or red bean paste and syrup, or savoury with minced pork and soup. The Cantonese call these rice balls "Tong Yuen". The rice balls and the bowl in which they are served symbolise family togetherness, happiness and good luck.

Many years ago, young people were "chaperoned" in the streets in the hope of finding love, with the help of matchmakers.

With the passing of time, this custom has lost its popularity, except for the tradition of eating the rice balls which continues in many Asian countries.


