In recent months there have been some major changes in the children's services.

From July 2, the Child Care Subsidy will replace the existing child care benefit and child care rebate, supported by a child care safety net. This new child care procedure is supposed to give the most vulnerable children a strong start, while supporting parents into work.

We have been asked by the Australian Institute of Family Studies to submit our views on this change.

We are at the moment compiling a survey with our views and concerns.

We need to ensure that all parents who receive this service, are informed of this information, of these changes and of the regulations.

Any parent who requires any further information on this can contact our child care coordinator staff. We will be more than happy to assist as best we can with these changes.

#### Dear Parents,

As you may already know, from 2 July 2018, the new Child Care Subsidy (CCS) system will come into effect. This will replace the current Child Care Benefit (CCB) and Child Care Rebate (CCR) arrangement and makes it easier for families to access childcare.

The onus is on parents to create their MyGov account and apply for the subsidy through Centrelink.

If you are needing assistance registering with MyGov, we can help you. Please contact Katina to arrange an appointment on a Monday or Tuesday only between the hours of 9am-2pm. **Please Note:** This help is not provided while the educators are on duty, as we are very strict with all educators being with the children for their care.

#### Vacation Care

The April school holidays at Hurstville Vacation Care were lots of fun for the children and staff who came along and enjoyed the two weeks of our wonderful educational program. The excursions included AMF bowling in Southgate, going to the movies at Events Cinema Hurstville, Glow Crazy indoor party Centre in Carlton, Chipmunks indoor play Centre in Bankstown and Kingsgrove Community Centre which included an incursion about sustainability and up cycling. The Incentre days included a nature walk through the school were the children collected items they could use for craft, cubby house and movies day the children could bring in a movie of their choice to watch with their friends. This gives the children the opportunity to bond and make new friends as well as developing their communication and teamwork skills while making their cubby house. They also enjoyed a Treasure hunt activity which we program each vacation care due to popular demand by the children.
