POPPY PLAYGROUP - HELPING MOTHER'S TO COPE



POPPY Playgroup (Parent's Opportunity to Participate in Play with their Young) is a supported playgroup specifically for mothers who have mental health challenges. It operates at the Kingsgrove Community Aid Centre On Monday's 10:30am till 12:30pm.

Michelle, a regular participant says:

"I joined POPPY Playgroup as a way to connect with other parents and also, I guess to learn more about raising my kids.

I heard about it through a referral through the child health centre I was going to. One of the nurses referred me to it. I've been coming for 3 years, since my daughter was 11 months old.

It has helped me in lots of ways. Just meeting other parents in similar situations as a way to combat the isolation that comes from being a stay at home parent with young children. Learning information about how to manage their emotional outbursts, tips

about sleep both for them and for myself. Relevant issues, everything from domestic violence to taking care of yourself, putting on your oxygen mask first before you can help others is a good lesson that I've learnt and helping yourself before you can help your family and your kids.

I've learned new techniques to better help me cope, things like having a routine for taking time out just to stop and breath and be mindful every day.

Attending this group has given me a connection to other parents and gives my daughter someone to play with, she always asks when are we going to playgroup?

Its always got a variety of activities for the kids and someone to talk to such as the staff, mental healthcare workers, other parents.

I drive to get to the group each Monday, there used to be a transport service to help get people here before funding was decreased and I've noticed attendance has dropped off after that stopped, but sometimes parents just stop coming because their kids are going to school.



In coming to this playgroup, I've met many people going through similar things and it helps you realise that you're not alone. Even just to talk about things that parents who don't have mental illness won't necessarily understand. Even ways that I wouldn't have anticipated like, my daughter's pretty shy and even though she goes to day care she find playgroup less confronting as it's a smaller group. Just coming here over the years has increased her confidence in dealing with groups of people. She has made good friends here.



I see myself coming back next year and I say to others to definitely come along and if you already come along keep coming. Sometimes I feel like I'm too tired or have too much on but if I force myself to come here it just makes my day better and makes it easier to cope. We also get together outside of POPPY time, so I've made some really good friends through this group.

I would highly recommend people joining this playgroup."

DIWALI, FESTIVAL OF LIGHTS 2018

Diwali was celebrated on Wednesday 31st October at the Kingsgrove Community Aid Centre with a colourful array of multi-coloured Diyas and the sand art of Rangoli welcoming the crowds as they arrived. Over 400 people attended the days event which was organised by the Kingsgrove Community Aid Centre in Partnership with the Resourceful Australian Indian Network (RAIN) and Georges River Council.

Guests welcomed the festival of light wearing traditional saris in many colours mixing and mingling together from many cultures.

Acknowledgement of Country began the event by Ms Brenda Eggleton from Georges River Council signifying the traditional custodians of the land and paying homage to the ancestors past and present.

High Priest Pundit Paras Maharaj showered traditional Diwali blessings on all present for good health and peace extending his blessings to the Community Aid Centre and its members and staff to continue receiving resources to be able to serve the needs of those most vulnerable in the community.

CEO Anne Farah Hill in her opening speech spoke about the significance of Diwali in a local western perspective. "Through light the beauty of this world is revealed. Light is a metaphor for knowledge and through knowledge we aim to destroy negative forces, weaknesses, injustice oppression and suffering". "By organising this festival, we bring people together from all cultures" Ms Farah Hill says. HURSTVILLE OUT OF SCHOOL HOURS CARE & VACATION CARE

In term 3 2018, our educators were very busy preparing a fun and creative program for the children. This included Chinese moon festival, Grandparents week, craft activities and displaying children's art work and making lots of fun creative craft including colouring in competitions. Out October vacation care program went very well. We went to The Movies at Greater Union Hurstville, Zone Bowling in Southgate, The Powerhouse Museum, Glow crazy Party Centre in Carlton and had a fun Multicultural incursion day at KCAC.

Our Homework help program has been very successful and will continue to be available in term 4 on Mondays and Wednesdays between 4 and 5pm. This program is sponsored by Kingsgrove Community Aid Centre. Organised activities the children participated in are Halloween, Melbourne Cup, Xmas craft and outdoor nature play. Indoor activities and games the children are interested in are puzzles, board games such as scrabble, connect 4, monopoly and chess. Our educational activities include crosswords, word search, colouring by numbers. Our recreational activities include playing schools ,playing shops , musical chairs, musical statues playing guitar, Lego and mobile. On Friday afternoon we encourage children to make something from items in our recycle container to encourage sustainability we are also encouraging children to play outside and be involved in the HOOSH aarden project. This term we have arown beans and cucumbers. We planted these next to the mint and parsley. During vacation care we cut the beans and served them for afternoon tea. We also added fresh mint from the garden to our HOOSH water to give it a nicer taste and encourage children to drink more water. Outdoor activities include playing twister, creating an obstacle course using the balance beams in the playground and playing ballgames and interacting with friends. Parents are welcome to view images of these activities in our programming and reflection journal located next to the sign out book. Families may also follow us on Instagram to view images posted of these activities.

The last day of school for Term 4 will be Wednesday 19 December 2018 we will be open on 20 and 21 December for vacation care. Our Centre will be closed from Monday 24 December to Friday 4 January for the Christmas and New Year break. We will reopen for Vacation care on Monday 7 January 2019. The program will run for 3 weeks up to the 25 January. Monday 28 January is the Australia Day public holiday. On the 29 January we will run a vacation care day and school will resume as normal on Wednesday 30 January 2019.
