TERNATIONAL DAY OF PEOPLE WITH DISA













To celebrate International Day of People with a Disability, Kingsgrove Community Aid Centre unveiled a masterpiece called "Wonderland" created by students of its Disability Art Class and Day Care program on Wednesday 6 December. Chief Executive Officer of Kingsgrove Community Aid Centre, Anne Farrah Hill says the aim of the Disability Art Program is to empower local people with a disability to engage with and be active contributors to their community. "We've launched this artwork as a celebration of the program and to demonstrate the enjoyment that our participants get out of exploring their creativity," said Mrs Farah Hill. "We've been supporting young people with disabilities and their families for the past five years and designed this program to provide activities and services for people who are 18 years and over in the Kingsgrove and St George areas. We were grateful to receive a \$13,000 grant from Club Central Hurstville which enabled us to provide this as a free service to the community," she said. Club Central Director, Sandra Coogan, helped launch the artwork and congratulated the group on the finished piece. "What a better way to celebrate International Day of People with a Disability than to unveil a masterpiece created by some talented locals. It's fantastic to see the difference this program is making and Club Central is proud to be able to support community members with a disability to connect and engage with each other in a meaningful way," said Ms Coogan. The "Wonderland" artwork has been created by a group of students ranging in age from 19 to 76 and depicts the beauties of the local environment, full of sunshine, trees, flowers and butterflies. A further eight pieces of art from KCAC's Disability Art Class will be framed and displayed at the Civic Theatre Hurstville with electronic copies on screen rotation at Westfield Hurstville, as part of the Georges River Council's International Day of People with Disability celebrations. As well as gaining significant enjoyment from the art and craft activities, the participants have shown improvements in their interpersonal and independent living skills through the yoga and cooking segments of the program. "The program has been an outstanding success with 15-25 participants for every session since it began in February this year. Based on the feedback we hope to continue the program and introduce more fun activities with clay modelling, singing, dancing, cooking and outdoor activities," said Ms Farah Hill. Other guest speakers who attended this event were Councillor Nancy Liu of Georges River Council and Mr Mark Coure MP, State member for Oatley. 
The staff of the Kingsgrove Community Aid Centre enjoyed their Christmas party at Gebran Restaurant on Saturday the 2nd December 2017.




