Coming together each week helps the group feel more connected and living in their own homes longer gives them much joy. If you would like to join this group or any of our other social support groups, call us on 91507823.













RECIPE OF THE MONTH - CHOC CARAMEL SLICE

Ingredients:

Base:

1 cup plain flour1/2 cup almond meal125 grams unsalted butter, melted

Filling:

1/3 cup golden syrup125 grams unsalted butter, melted2 cans sweetened condensed milk

Topping:

200 grams dark cooking chocolate 2 tsp vegetable oil



Preheat oven to 180°C

Place flour, almond meal, butter & sugar in a bowl & mix well to combine Press mixture into a lined slice tin and bake for 15 mins, then allow to cool

For the filling, place golden syrup, butter and condensed milk into a saucepan over low heat and stir for 6 - 8 mins until thickened slightly.

Pour filling over base and bake for 20 mins or until golden. Refrigerate for 30 mins or until cooled completely. Place chocolate and oil into heatproof bowl over simmering water until melted and smooth. Spread over slice and refrigerate for 2 hours or until set. Slice to serve. Enjoy!

The service has welcomed many new children and families. We hope these new additions to our OSHC community have settled in well by engaging in routines and forming new and valuable relationships.

Vacation Care Recap: The December/January Vacation Care Period was a very busy time; jam packed with many exciting activities and experiences which the children absolutely loved.

A variety of hands-on and interactive experiences were conducted throughout the Vacation Care period, where the children attended various excursions, such as the Beverly Hills Cinema, Glow Crazy, Carss Bush Park, Manhattan Super Bowl and Kingsgrove Community Centre Day.

Throughout these learning activities, the children displayed respect, success and creativity; whilst forming many positive relationships ready for their new year at OSHC

Goals/Vision: Despite the many changes that have occurred at OSHC, we are optimistic and have many exciting plans and goals in action. For example, we are aiming to create and display a variety of signs for the OSHC, to assist caregivers with finding the service.

Additionally, the OSHC policies and QUIP will be revised and adjusted with the necessary changes for 2019. Our vision for the OSHC room is to create a more interactive and dramatic play area, catering to both the children's needs but also interests. This will be a space where children can explore and enjoy free play in real-world contexts.

Staff Outlets employs staff with appropriate qualifications, skills and experience. These include Working with Children's Checks, Police Checks, Protecting Children-Mandatory reporting, Anaphylaxis, Asthma Training, CPR and First Aid certificates.

HURSTVILLE OUT OF SCHOOL HOURS CARE & VACATION CARE

Dear Parents.

Term 4 2018 was very busy for Hurstville OOSH with our educators preparing a fun and creative program for the children. This included Halloween, Melbourne Cup and lots of fun Christmas craft. We also had a Christmas colouring in competition where we displayed the children's art work and made lots of fun creative craft including nature art. The term ended with an always popular end of year Christmas party and a farewell for the year six students. We wish them all the best for 2019 in their first year in High School. We met 15 new kindergarten children who attended orientation day with their parents in early November and enrolled in our OOSH service.

Term 4 ended on 19 December and vacation care began. The first two days were the Thursday and Friday before Christmas. On Thursday, we stayed in the Centre and did lots of fun Christmas craft and cooking. On the Friday we walked the Children to Westfield and bought them lunch in the food court. After a play on the Westfield playground equipment, we watched the NSW Fire and Rescue band play Christmas carols to raise money for the Kids Burns Unit.

After a two week break, we returned to Vacation care on the 7 January 2019 to begin a new educational adventure. This included 8 excursion and seven in centre days.

The excursions included The Movies at Greater Union Hurstville, Pancakes on the Rocks at Beverly Hills, Zone Bowling at Southgate, The Australian Museum, Glow Crazy Party Centre in Carlton, Chipmunks indoor play Centre, Picnic lunch at Blaxland River Park and a fun laser tag incursion at KCAC.

In Term 1 2109, our Homework Help program will continue to be available on Mondays and Wednesdays between 4 and 5pm. This program is sponsored by Kingsgrove Community Aid Centre. Our educators are busy programming craft ideas for the children through their interests including themes such as Chinese New Year, Valentine's day, St Patrick's Day Harmony Day, Easter, indoor outdoor games and nature play. Indoor activities and games the children are interested in are puzzles, board games such as scrabble, connect 4, monopoly and chess. Our educational activities include crosswords, word search, colouring by numbers, counting blocks and much more. Our children's choice recreational activities include playing schools, playing shops, musical chairs, musical statues, playing guitar, playing families, playing with train set, Lego and mobile construction. On Friday afternoons, we encourage children to make something from items in our recycle container to encourage sustainability we are also encouraging children to play outside and be involved in the HOOSH garden project. This term we will grow herbs such as parsley, mint and coriander. The children enjoy adding slices of fruit or fresh mint leaves from the garden to our water jugs to give it a nicer taste. This encourages children to drink more water. Outdoor activities include playing twister, creating an obstacle course using the balance beams in the playground and playing ballgames and interacting with friends.

Parents are welcome to view images of these activities in our programming and reflection journal located next to the sign out book. Families may also follow us on Instagram to view images posted of these activities.

The last day of school for Term 1 will be Friday 12 April 2019. We will open for Vacation care on Monday 15 April 2019. The program will run for 2 weeks which will include 3 Public Holidays which are 19,22 and 25 April. Monday 29 April is Pupil Free day and we will run vacation care on that day. Before and After School Care will resume as normal on Tuesday 30 April 2019.






